### **Winter Olympics in Cortina**

What this will mean for the accessibility of the slopes of Cortina d'Ampezzo is still not entirely clear. That is why BergXperience only organizes <u>ski hut tours to Cortina</u> at the beginning of January, the rest of the season we will discover <u>other parts of the Dolomiti Super Ski Area</u>. Don't wait too long, as the huts in the other parts will get booked up faster now many tours cannot go to Cortina.





### Summer season in full swing

June 14<sup>th</sup> was the day: the huts opened. Four groups immediately set off for a 4- or 5-day trip. At higher altitudes there were still some snowfields, but that was not an obstacle, on the contrary, it makes hiking early in the season extra special. From that moment on, a few groups started a nice trip every week.

## September superb hiking month

September is one of the most beautiful months for hiking in the Dolomites. The weather is very pleasant: the heat has disappeared and the weather is mostly more stable than in August. The sky is also clearer, so the views are even more spectacular. Don't forget to to bring warm clothes, because as soon as the sun is gone, it cools down seriously, especially at higher altitudes. Also keep in mind that most huts close after the third week of

September. Look here for a nice trip in September.





#### Alta Via 1 (AV1)

The Alta Via 1 has now become a 'bucket list' experience. People from all over the world want to hike this itinerary. So if you want to hike the AV1, you'll have to book early. Especially the northern part and the part around Cinque Torri are already fully booked around January. On the southern part of the AV1, where BergXperience organizes most of the tours, it is still possible to find availability shortly in advance. But you have to be a bit flexible. Please keep in mind: the hut season is short and hiking is becoming increasingly popular. Booking in time is important, because the capacity in the huts is limited.

### **Packinglist Summer**

Among the information BergXperience sends before the start of a tour is a packing list. Many guests indicate again and again how convenient they experience this list, because it is hard to decide what to bring and, even more important, what not to bring. After all, you have to carry everything with you all day, so packing as little as possible is important! What is also experienced as conventient is that for a small fee some gear can be borrowed from BergXperience. So you don't have to bring (or buy) everything yourselve.
