Last spots ski hut tours

When asked which month I think is the most beautiful for skiing, my answer is invariably: January. Although the days are shorter, I like the conditions the best. Good snow, beautiful light and here in the Dolomites the weather is often nice, even in January. Many people have already registered for a ski hut tour, so the winter is almost fully booked. But especially in beautiful January there are still [some possibilities](#), both for the tours on registration and for a [private tour](#). There are also a few places available for the [tour in March](#).

Winter Olympics in Cortina d'Ampezzo

The Winter Olympics will be held in Cortina from 6 to 21 February, [view the schedule here](#). Now we already know what the consequences are for skiing in the region. All slopes are available until mid-January, including in Cortina. From then until the end of January, part of the slopes will be closed for the preparation of the competition tracks. From the end of January to mid-March, all slopes on the Tofana side of Cortina are closed to skiers. At Faloria and Cinque Torri you can ski as usual. Early January we will have a glance at the [olympic slopes](#) in Cortina with BergXperience.



Ski helmet mandatory

From this season, wearing a ski helmet is mandatory in Italy for all ages. Until recently, this was only applied to children and young people under the age of 18. For many people, wearing a ski helmet is already the norm, but now it is also required by law. In practice, therefore, not much will change. In Italy, rules have been in place on the slopes for some time to prevent accidents, such as the obligation to have liability insurance. There are also checks on alcohol and drugs and there are speed limits, depending on the weather and crowds.



New hikingtours in 2026

For next summer, BergXperience has two beautiful new hiking tours on offer. The [Zoldo Panorama Route](#) is a beautiful tour along a few (literal) highlights of the Zoldo Valley, such as the monte Punta and the monte Rite. 360 Degree view guaranteed! The tough route goes on very quiet paths through a little-known part of the valley. This summer I walked several routes [around the Antelao](#) in the neighboring

Cadore Valley. What a beautiful itineraries and such nice authentic rifugios! Several beautiful tours can be made here, all around the Antelao and partly along the flanks of the Marmarole.



Hut-to-hut tour with children popular

This summer, many families have booked a [hut-to-hut tour](#) with BergXperience. The composition varied from families with (very) young children (the youngest was 1.5 years old) to teenagers who made a nice hike with their parents.
